



# 2017 CALF SCRAMBLE

#### **GENERAL**:

- a. Calf Scramble scholarship applications are available online at <u>www.angelinabenefitrodeo.com</u> or by obtaining a copy from your local 4-H or FFA leader or ag-teacher.
- b. The Angelina Benefit Rodeo Association Inc. is not responsible for any accidents which may occur to any participant in the Calf Scramble before, during, or after the event.
- c. All qualified applicants will be required to participate in the scramble which will take place during the Angelina Benefit Rodeo to be held **April 26, 27, 28, & 29 2017** in Lufkin at the George H. Henderson Exposition Center.
- All participants will be required to attend a mandatory orientation meeting Tuesday April 25<sup>th</sup> at 4:00
  PM at the Exposition Center main arena.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- a. Applicants must be enrolled in and considered eligible in a Texas 4-H or FFA at the time of application and if selected, at the time of scramble. Applicants MUST be a United States citizens and MUST possess a valid social security number
- b. Applicants must be enrolled in and attending a public or private secondary school in the state of Texas in Angelina County.
- c. Applicants must be currently in their senior year in high school.

## PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT:

- a. Participants must be able to run and perform procedures necessary to scramble.
- b. Applicant must weigh at least 100 pounds
- c. Participants appearing to have broken limbs or evidence of a recent injury (cast, ace bandage, support brace, etc.) will automatically be disqualified and replaced by the first eligible alternate.
- d. <u>Dress</u>: Participants must wear long pants and comfortable shoes. A T-shirt will be provided for each participant to wear during the event prior to the event. Shoes with any type of knob or clear are not allowed. A belt is not required but strongly suggested. Please remember that you will be running in dirt, so the more comfortable you are, the easier it is to run.

## SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT REQUIREMENT:

- a. Participants that successfully compete in the calf scramble event and receive a scholarship are required to provide a thank-you letter to the Angelina Benefit Rodeo.
- All thank you letters are to be received by the Angelina Benefit Rodeo or post marked on or before September 30<sup>th</sup> 2017 or scholarship funds will be forfeited.
- c. All thank you letters should include a copy of the student's tuition bill or proof of enrollment in any school of higher education beyond high school.
